



Pullman Barcelona Skipper



Formerly the Hotel AB Skipper, this property was taken over by Accor this summer under its business-oriented Pullman brand. The hotel is located in the city's Port Olympic district, next to Hotel Arts (a Ritz-Carlton property) and overlooking the marina and Frank Gehry's iconic Fish sculpture.

As the original hotel was only opened in 2006 it's been more of a rebranding exercise than a refurbishment, but rooms still feel modern, with a dark red and grey decor, a leather chair and coffee table, flatscreen TV, DVD player and free wifi internet access. Most rooms also have balconies, with many having views towards the marina. There are two outdoor swimming pools, one on the ground floor terrace area, and another on the rooftop along with a spa bath.
